2015 An Historic Year

2015 is an historic year for Harristown as for many Queensland state high schools as Year 6s move into the high school setting. We are excited to welcome Year 6 and Year 7 children from across a range of primary schools next year. A new building, renovated classrooms and a purpose built playground are being constructed in preparation. Curriculum plans are being developed. Primary teachers are sharing their expertise by joining the Harristown Staff Team.
