Sun Safety	A personal hat, sunscreen and water bottle are required. General use water and sunscreen will be available.
Meals	No canteen will be available at the venue. Students are advised to bring their own healthy snacks and water bottle.
Behaviour	Students are expected to comply with the school's Student Code of Conduct 2021-2024 (refer to school website
expectations	for details). School policy applies for mobile phone unless advised by the supervising teacher.
Supervision	Various HSHS staff will be at the venue for the running of the event and general student supervision.
