	school website for details). School policy applies for mobile phone use.
	Students will have the opportunity to move around and spectate at events. Students MUST sit in the
	designated spectator area for that event. Each designated spectator area will be supervised by a
	school staff member.
Supervision arrangements	School staff.
Risk level	Activities involved carry medium and high* risks with a reasonable chance of injury requiring first aid or medical attention. Risk management processes are in place to minimise the likelihood of injury. Parents are advised that the Department of Education does not have personal accident insurance for students. If your child is injured as a result of an accident or incident while participating in the activity, all costs associated with the injury, including medical costs are the responsibility of the parent/carer. It is up to all parents/carers to decide the type/s and level of private insurance they wish to arrange to cover their child Please take this into consideration in deciding whether or not to allow the child/student to participate in this activity.  *Javelin, Discus and High Jump (Fosbury Flop) are considered high risk activities. Any student who is identified as being incompetent by the qualified event coordinator during the warm-up of these events may be withdrawn from the event for their own and others' safety.
