Before commencing the delivery of the above-named VET Certificate Courses, I have been informed that:

- **Pre-requisites for Entry** to these VET Certificate courses are NIL.
- **Learning Experiences** are comprised of a range of teaching and learning strategies which will be designed to deliver the competencies. These may include practical tasks including projects, group work and activities in simulated work environments
- **Assessment** is competency based and therefore no levels of achievement are awarded.
- **Pathways** exist in the industry area for which students have achieved their Qualification and may exist for those students who have achieved a Statement of Attainment.
- **Fees** will apply for the following VET Certificate courses in 2015. The costs are for both Years 11 and 12, where applicable – Construction (\$ 50.00), Engineering (\$ 60.00), Hospitality (\$ 50.00), and Kitchen Operations (\$ 50.00), but, these are for consumables. These prices will be given to students at the start of next year; however, students will be advised of these costs via the Student Participation Agreement form, daily Student Notices in Term 4 and through their current trainers and assessors. You may also ask the HOD of the relevant faculty about the cost.
- **Further Information** can be found by contacting the HOD responsible for each certificate or the HOD Senior Schooling. For information regarding support services and other general VET information, students will be provided with access to the VET Student Handbook prior to enrolment or they may contact the HOD Senior Schooling in D011.
- **A Service Agreement** exists to cover each of these two year VET courses. This agreement occurs with the signing of the Subject Selection form. As the RTO (Registered Training Organisation), Harristown SHS guarantees that the student will be provided with every opportunity to complete the certificate as per the rights and obligations outlined in the enrolment process and information handbook provided, eg: Senior Student Handbook and VET Student Handbook – see HSHS website. Students successfully achieving all qualification requirements will be provided with a qualification and record of results. Students who achieve at least one unit (but not the full qualification) will receive a Statement of Attainment. This information is correct at time of publication but subject to change.
- **International Students** may not be able to complete their selected certificate/s if they either:
 - (a) Enter the course through late entry and /or
 - (b) Exit the course earlier than the two year period of delivery.

Issuing of a Qualification or Statement of Attainment to International Students will be subject to the statement in the above Service Agreement.

- **Other Information** such as RPL (Recognition of Prior Learning), Credit Transfer and Complaints and Appeals Procedures can be found in the HSHS Senior Student Handbook as well as the VET Student Handbook – both documents are found on the HSHS website.
